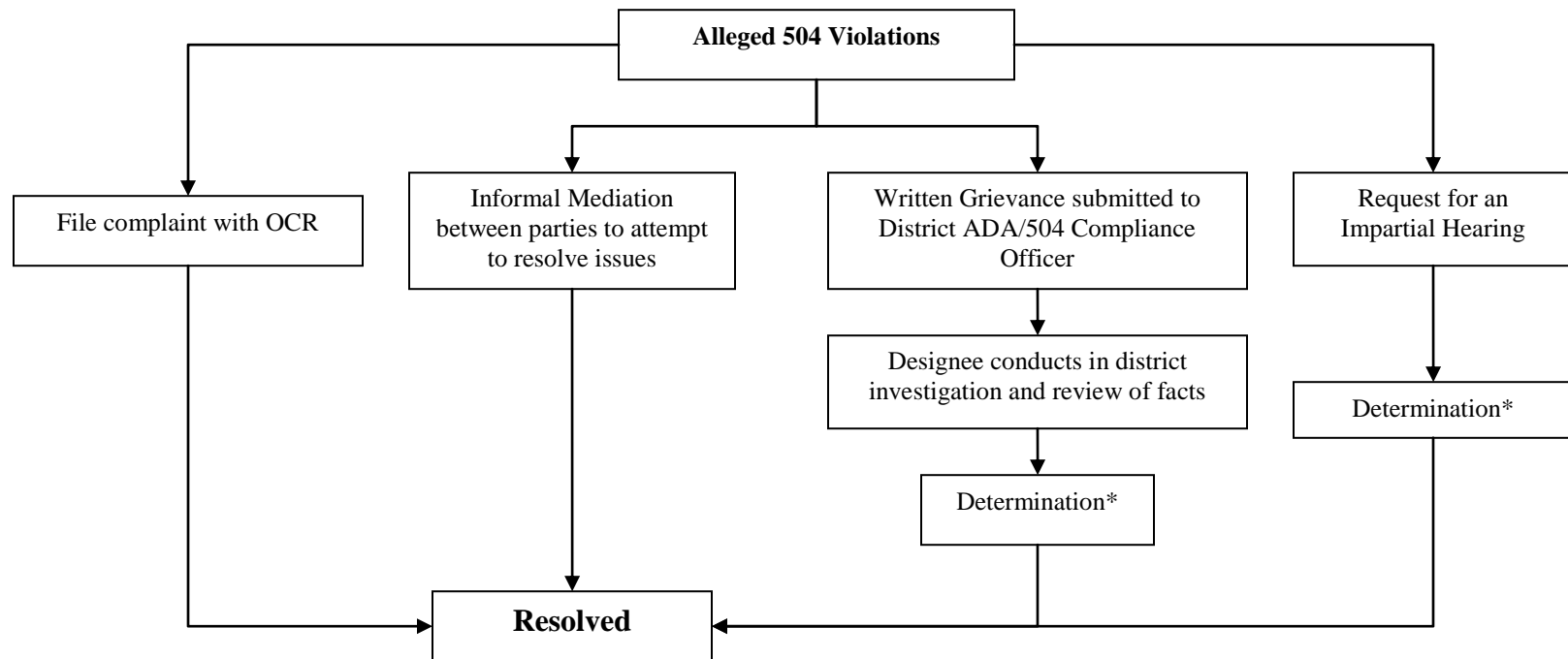


**DENVER PUBLIC SCHOOLS
ADA/SECTION 504 RESOLUTION PROCEDURES**

Any person with a disability who believes that officials of the Denver Public Schools or any of the district's staff have discriminated against him/her in violation of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 may bring forward a complaint, which shall be referred to as a grievance, to John Liberatore, ADA/Section 504 Compliance Officer. District guidelines allow for different administrative processes including, informal mediation, formal grievance and/or due process hearing procedures. It should be understood by the individual(s) involved that a complaint can be made to the Office of Civil Rights without going through the school district's grievance procedures. The grievance procedures are to provide for a prompt and equitable resolution of a complaint.
